We are seeking a casual driver to join our Community Transport Team to assist us in delivering our community transport service.

About the role

You would be involved in delivering a safe and reliable transport service that operates door-to-door for our clients. In this role you would get to know our clients and be able to accommodate their needs by assisting them in and out of the vehicle, securing and storing their shopping or mobility device and ensuring they are seated safely.

Working independently or alongside other team members, including our wonderful volunteers, you will collect our clients from home and transport them to their destination and then transport them home afterwards. Depending on the trip you are conducting you may even be joining the social group for lunch at one of the local eateries across the district.

Your commitment to on-going training and skill development will be needed to keep up to date with the changing work environment for our industry, as we enter into the new Support At Home Program.
